- Conversion Disorder = Functional Neurological Symptom Disorder (DSM-5), is a psychiatric illness characterised by involuntary neurological symptoms in the absence of organicity
- Aim of study discuss the role of stigma
- 35-year-old woman
- significant psychiatric history of PTSD and Major Depression
- symptoms in remission while on treatment
- complaints of limb paralysis and difficulty in walking
- awoke with limb weakness and paraesthesia requiring her to ambulate using a stick / wheelchair
- improved over 3–6 weeks, next 6-months later with right-sided paralysis
- went to an emergency department
- Collapsing-weakness at the review led to a opinion of psychological cause
- misdiagnosed with Conversion Disorder despite classical symptoms of MS




Case studies

- Conclusion: EDs have been considered as high-risk areas for errors which make psychiatric patients even more prone to misdiagnosis
